On August 24, 2022, Cannabees Logistics LLC, d/b/a Cannasourc'd Logistics, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Motor Freight Carrier carrier in the state of Washington.

On November 1, 2022, the Commission sent Cannabees Logistics LLC notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Despite this notice, Cannabees Logistics LLC has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: Did not provide insurance filing.
