**AMENDED NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE
(September 4, 2001)**

1 On August 24, 2001, the Commission issued a Notice of Prehearing Conference in Docket No. UE-011170 concerning the petition of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. for an order authorizing deferral of expenditures for certain electric energy supply costs. The notice cited a related request by the company in Docket No. UE-011163 for approval of an electric tariff rider (Schedule 395) for recovery of certain electric energy supply costs. The Commission stated that, if the effect of the tariff rider is suspended at the Commission's August 29, 2001, Open Meeting, the Commission will set for prehearing conference Docket No. UE-011163 on the same day and at the same time and place specified for Docket No. UE-011170 so that prehearing issues relevant to both matters may be considered. At its Open Meeting on August 29, 2001, the Commission suspended the effect of the tariff rider in Docket No. UE-011163.

2 **NOTICE IS THEREFORE GIVEN** that prehearing conferences in both Docket No. UE-011170 and Docket No. UE-011163 will be convened at 1:30 p.m., on

Tuesday, September 4, 2001, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. In addition to those issues noted previously, the ultimate issues include whether the proposed tariff rider is just, fair, reasonable, and sufficient, and in the public interest. In accordance with the provisions of RCW 80.04.130, the burden of proof to show that the rates produced by the tariff rider are just and reasonable shall be upon the respondent. In all other respects, the Notice of Prehearing Conference, issued August 24, 2001, remains in full force and effect in both referenced dockets.
