### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 2 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including electric companies. *RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 80.04 RCW and Chapter 80.28 RCW.*
- 3 (2) PSE is an electric company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 4 (3) On April 27, 2004, PSE filed a Periodic Adjustment Application for revision of Schedule 80 in accordance with the mechanisms set forth in the Conservation Asset Transaction, and on April 28, 2004, submitted a substitute tariff page.
- 5 (4) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 26, 2004.
