**BACKGROUND**

- 1     On March 1, 2006, Iliad Water Service, Inc., (Iliad Water) filed with the Commission a revision to its currently effective Tariff WN U-1, designated as Original Sheet No. W-104. The stated effective date is April 1, 2006. The proposed tariff revision would institute a one-time assessment collectable from the customers of the Alder Lake Community Water System.
  
- 2     The filing would increase charges and rates for service provided by Iliad Water. Because those increases might injuriously affect the rights and interests of the public and Iliad Water has not demonstrated that the increases would result in rates that are fair, just and reasonable, the Commission suspends the tariff filing and will hold public hearings if necessary to determine whether the proposed increases are fair, just and reasonable.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

- 3     (1)     The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including water companies. *RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 80.04 RCW; Chapter 80.28 RCW, Chapter 80.08 RCW, and Chapter 80.12 RCW.*
  
- 4     (2)     Iliad Water is a water company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

- 5 (3) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 29, 2006.
- 6 (4) The tariff revision filed by Iliad Water on March 1, 2006, would increase charges and rates for service provided by Iliad Water, and might injuriously affect the rights and interest of the public.
- 7 (5) Iliad Water has not yet demonstrated that the tariff revision would result in rates that are fair, just and reasonable.
- 8 (6) In order to carry out the duties imposed upon the Commission by law, and as authorized in RCW 80.04.130, the Commission believes it is necessary to investigate Iliad Water's books, accounts, practices and activities; to make a valuation or appraisal of Iliad Water's property; and to investigate and appraise various phases of Iliad Water's operations.
- 9 (7) As required by RCW 80.04.130 (4), Iliad Water bears the burden of proof to show that the proposed increases are fair, just and reasonable.
- 10 (8) Iliad Water may be required to pay the expenses reasonably attributable and allocable to such an investigation to the extent the requirements for such payment are in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80.20 RCW.

**ORDER**

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

- 11 (1) The tariff revision filed on March 1, 2006, is suspended.
- 12 (2) The Commission will hold hearings at such times and places as may be required.
- 13 (3) Iliad Water Service, Inc., must not change or alter the tariffs filed in this docket during the suspension period, unless authorized by the Commission.
- 14 (4) The Commission will institute an investigation of Iliad Water Service, Inc.'s, books, accounts, practices, activities, property and operations as described above.

- 15 (5) Iliad Water Service, Inc., shall pay the expenses reasonably attributable and allocable to the Commission's investigation to the extent the requirements for such payment are in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80.20 RCW.
