RULES AND REGULATIONS

Page one

Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. C-862

RULE NO. 1

1. **ADULT FARES:** fares published herein are adult fares, unless otherwise indicated, and apply to passengers as indicated on fare sheets.
2. **SPECIAL FARES:** Special reduced fares for students; seniors 62 and under; military with ID; Airline and Travel Agent with ID; Fulltime Students with ID; Children 11 years old and under ride at Child rate with maximum of (1) one child fare per each adult fare. Identification may be required.
3. **COMMUTER FARES:** Commuter rates with one-way tickets purchased at same time and which are Non-transferable, shall be as specified in the fares attached.
4. **CONVENTION RATES:** As outlined on fare sheets. Convention fares are non-refundable.
5. **GROUP FARES:** When persons representing the same firm, agency, club or organization are traveling together they may all travel at group fares provided advanced reservations have been made. Identification may be required. Fares are specified on the attached fare sheet.
5. **TICKET REDEMPTION:** Unused tickets or portions thereof will be redeemed when presented by the lawful owner within three months from date of sale. Unused portions of one-way, roundtrip or commuter tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portions used plus one Dollar service charge and refunding the balance of the purchase price. Commuter fare tickets will be redeemed by charging the lowest fare applicable to the actual transportation used and refunding the balance of the purchase price, when presented with cover of the book or receipt to the selling agent.

Tickets sold at group rate for special fares are not refundable.
6. **PROPERTY DAMAGE:** Carrier assumes liability for damage to baggage not exceeding common Liability limits as specified in law.
7. **BAGGAGE RULES AND CHARGES:** Passengers are responsible for the correct identification and retrieval of their luggage. Please tag all luggage prior to boarding the shuttle. Each passenger is allowed two articles (under 70 pounds each and measuring less than 70" L+W+H each). Plus a small carry on.
There will be a \$3.00 minimum charge for each additional, oversize and/or overweight bag. Previous Arrangements must be made with the office during office hours for oversized boxes, trunks and cartons.
Bicycles – must be packed in a box (max. 8"Wx24"Hx60"L). A fee will be charged for extra and over Size luggage. Bicycles are charged \$10.00 per bicycle between any two points.
Skis, Golf Bags, Snowboards \$5.00 each.
Animals in Kennels\$5.00/\$10.00/\$15.00 (3 different sizes.)
Dogs known as a SERVICE DOG ARE THE ONLY dogs allowed on board/on a leash/harnessed. The Passenger with the dog will sit on the front passenger seat.

Pets must be in a hardshell, airline approved kennel and ride in the cargo compartment.

8. **RESERVATIONS:** Reservations required on all departures to assure seat. Walk-ons are always Accepted on a space-available basis.

9. **SCHEDULE MAINTENANCE:** It is our purpose to maintain scheduled time whenever possible. Safety is our primary factor. Weather, traffic, and other factor may affect operating conditions and time of pick-up or drop-off. Therefore, scheduled times cannot be guaranteed. Information for boarding locations is available on-line.

Passengers are requested to be prepared for pick-up 10 minutes prior to their scheduled pick-up time.

10. **RETURNED CHECKS:** a \$40.00 SERVICE CHARGE ON ALL RETURNED CHECKS
A Guarantee charge is charged on all credit card cancellations.
11. **SPECIAL SCHEDULES:** special schedules are observed on Holidays ie. Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Years Eve, New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, 4th of July, Memorial Day, and Labor Day. (others may occur as necessary to meet the general public need).
12. **OBJECTIONAL PASSENGERS:** This company reserves the right to refuse to transport persons Under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or incapable of taking care of themselves, or whose condition, conduct, or behavior may be objectionable to the other passengers.
