

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Date: April 17, 2006

Roche Harbor Water System, Inc. filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for an increase in water rates. The proposed effective date for the filing is May 17, 2006.

The purpose of this filing is to reflect the cost to the Company to provide water service. The Company has not had a general rate increase in over ten years. During that time, the cost to provide service has increased substantially. This filing will raise approximately \$89,398 in additional annual revenue if customers use the same quantities of water used in 2005. This represents an increase of approximately 38.6%.


The rates requested by the Company are:

Base	\$25.00/mo	\$25.00/mo
0-5,000 gallons	Included in Base	\$3.50/1,000 gallons
5,000-10,000 gallons	\$3.00/1,000 gallons	\$5.50/1,000 gallons
Over 10,000 gallons	\$5.50/1,000 gallons	\$8.50/1,000 gallons
