**BACKGROUND**

- 1     On April 26, 2007, Oasis Water Corporation (Oasis Water or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application seeking approval of a sale and transfer of all of the Company’s common stock.
  
- 2     Commission staff investigated the application to determine whether the purchase and sale of common stock was subject to Commission approval under RCW 80.12. According to the documents supplied by the Company, which are in the Commission’s file in this docket, the purchase and sale of common stock is between private parties, and the Company is not involved in that transaction.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

- 3     (1)    The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the state of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, rules, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including water companies. *RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04, RCW 80.08, RCW 80.12, and RCW 80.28.*
  
- 4     (2)    Oasis Water is a water company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
  
- 5     (3)    This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 12, 2007.

- 6 (4) The sale and transfer application Oasis Water filed in this docket is not subject to approval by the Commission because Oasis Water is not involved in that transaction.
- 7 (5) After reviewing the sale and transfer application Oasis Water filed in Docket UW-070803 and giving due consideration, the Commission finds it is consistent with the public interest to permit Oasis Water to withdraw the application.

**ORDER**

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

- 8 (1) The sale and transfer application Oasis Water Corporation filed in this docket is withdrawn.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Secretary to enter this Order.
