- 1 On March 10, 2008, GTS Shipping Window, Inc., d/b/a NW Relocation, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington as required by the provisions of RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-15. GTS Shipping Window, Inc.'s application is incomplete as it lacks a Unified Business Identifier number, registration with the Secretary of State's office and a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E).
- 2 The Commission sent GTS Shipping Window, Inc., a notice to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480.15. GTS Shipping Window, Inc. has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order..
- 3 The application filed by GTS Shipping Window, Inc., in Docket TV-080452 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC-15.

**ORDER**

- 4 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the application filed by GTS Shipping Window, Inc., Docket TV-080452 for household goods carrier authority is dismissed.
