A default judgment is one where plaintiff is entitled to what it asks

1 for because you have not responded. If you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned  
2 attorney, you are entitled to notice before a default judgment may be entered.

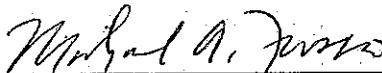
3 You may demand that the plaintiff file this lawsuit with the court. If you do so, the  
4 demand must be in writing and must be served upon the undersigned attorney. Within 14 days  
5 after you serve the demand, the plaintiff must file this lawsuit with the court, or the service on

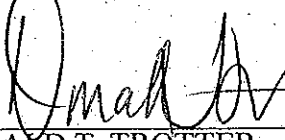
8 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly so
