Interconnection agreements requirements

Mr. Tarbert -

Here is the information that should be sent to Mr. Williams.

In the past, the UTC allowed companies to be approved for an ICA prior to registration as a telecommunications carrier. However, this policy has now been revised. The UTC will only approve the interconnection agreements of companies that are registered by this Commission to provide telecommunications services. It is still a state requirement that companies be registered by the Commission prior to providing any telecommunications services to end-users. The ICA that was submitted under UT-093020 was for interconnection, unbundled network elements, ancillary services, and resale of telecommunications services; therefore, should the parties negotiate any amendments, BCI will need to be registered with the UTC.
