Dear Mr. Hefley:

On January 19, 2011, Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad (PSAP) filed several Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) applications with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission). The Commission assigned Docket TR-110167 to the Foron Road application.

PSAP requested grant funds to contribute toward related crossing closure costs. On the same day that PSAP filed this GCPF application, a petition to close this crossing was also filed with the Commission.

On February 1, 2011, the Commission notified PSAP that the Commission could not act on the GCPF applications until a decision had been made on the closure petition.

On June 14, 2011, PSAP filed a motion to withdraw the petition. On June 23, 2011, the Commission granted the motion, thus making the GCPF application moot. The Commission has accordingly closed this docket.
