Recommendation

Issue a Complaint and Order Suspending the Tariff Revisions filed by Basin Water Sources, Inc., on July 20, 2011.

Discussion

On July 20, 2011, Basin Water Sources, Inc. (Basin or company) filed with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) a general rate case filing that would generate \$10,525 (10 percent) additional annual revenue. The stated effective date is October 1, 2011. The tariff reissuance, as WN U-2, updates tariff language, increases general rates and implements several new ancillary charges. The filing was prompted by costs for company operations exceeding revenues. It proposes to increase all charges to all customers by 10 percent to its unmetered service rate. The company had its last general rate case in August 2007. The company serves about 392 customers (all non-metered) near Moses Lake, in Grant County.

Using the proposed rates, a residential customer would pay \$2.65 (10 percent) more than the current rates (see "Average Bill Comparison" table below). Current and proposed rates are shown below for the general rate increase.

Ancillary Charge Comparison
