Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) project to modify active warning

devices at West First Street in Aberdeen (USDOT 808713U)

On February 9, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad (PSAP) a GCPF grant in the amount of \$20,000 to improve modify active warning devices at West First Street in Aberdeen (USDOT 808713U). The estimated project cost, before taxes, was \$43,145 with PSAP paying for all costs exceeding \$20,000.

On October 24, 2012, the applicant, PSAP, submitted a request for reimbursement for work pursuant to Commission order. Commission staff conducted a site visit of the crossing and verified that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
