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- 1 On June 2, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment UT-140920 against TeleManagement Systems, Inc. (TeleManagement Systems) in the amount of \$1,000, alleging a violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires permitted telecommunication companies to file annual reports with the Commission by May 1 each year and pay regulatory fees annually on that date.

- 2 On June 16, 2014, TeleManagement Systems filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating that it submitted a letter to the Commission in August 2013 saying that they would not be renewing their license as they no longer have customers/business in the state of Washington. In October 2013 TeleManagement submitted a Corporate Dissolution application and received a Department of Revenue Clearance Certificate. TeleManagement believed they were solvent, complete and had fulfilled all obligations related to the closing of business in Washington and that the closure paperwork had not caught up with the annual report requirement notices sent out by the Commission.

- 3 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the alleged violation of WAC 480-120-382 occurred and, if so, whether the penalty should be mitigated.

4 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, August 26, 2014, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**

5 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

6 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.

7 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 19, 2014**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and – 145.

8 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
