Dear Residential Customer,

This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for residential customers in the Lynnwood Disposal areas of Snohomish County. If the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission approves our request, customers will experience cost adjustments to recycling service provided by Lynnwood Disposal as outlined in the table below.

The rate case recently submitted and effective as of 7/1/2014 overrepresented the number of recycle only customers and the intention of this filing is to correct that. The rate for recycling service was \$7.67 prior to the 7/1/14 rate case and was dropped by 14% to \$6.60. With the proposed rate recalculation the rate is expected to increase to \$6.90 which is still a rate reduction of 10% from rates at the beginning of the year.

If approved, the proposed rates will become effective October 1, 2014.
