RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-151013

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 9, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Caring Hands in the amount of \$300 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household good carriers to file an annual report and pay regulatory fees with the Commission by May 1 each year. Caring Hands filed its 2014 annual report and paid its 2015 regulatory fee on May 6, 2015, three business days late, and has incurred a penalty of \$300. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 13, 2015, indicating that the balance of \$300 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$300 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$300 balance.
