1. Amend its filed Time Schedule No. 36 to discontinue using the additional service of the Lady Express boat and only use the Lady of the Lake II boat to provide commercial passenger service on Lake Chelan pursuant to WAC 480-51-090 (6)(e). Once the fire emergency is over the company will file a new Time Schedule with the Commission to resume service as normal.

Justification:

Due to the massive fire storms happening in the Lake Chelan area, we need to request to discontinue the additional summer service of the Lady Express until further notice. This vessel schedule normally ends on September 15, 2015. The daily service of the Lady of the Lake II will continue.
