BACKGRUUND

- Application is hereby made to the Washington Utilities and Transportation 1 Commission for an Order authorizing the transfer of property under the provisions of chapter 80.12 RCW and chapter 480-143 WAC.
- After transfer of assets to Grant Co Public Utility District, Crescent Bar, Inc. 2 request removal from commission regulation and to cancel our tariff.

INTRODUCTION

- 3 Crescent Bar, Inc. is a Washington corporation formed to act as a utility service company. Grant Co Public Utility District, located in Ephrata, WA is a Public Utility District and not subject to commission regulation under RCW 80.12. The water system to be transferred consists of wells, pumps, transmission mains, reservoirs, hydrants, distribution mains, meters, and appurtenances to serve the customers of the Crescent Bar. Inc.
- Crescent Bar, Inc. serves _495__ customers located near Quincy WA, located in 4 Grant County.
- 5 The water system is currently operating under a green operating permit issued by the Washington State Department of Health (ID #15950 T) and has no outstanding orders or letters directing action.

- As a result of this sale and transfer of water system assets, Grant Co PUD will provide all water services and will set all water rates by PUD rules and procedures.
- Crescent Bar, Inc. will no longer own or operate any assets that serve customers that would meet commission regulation. Crescent Bar, Inc. is requesting removal from regulation and cancels our current tariff.

The owners of Crescent Bar, Inc. no longer desire to own and operate a public water system. Customers were notified of the sale and transfer along with their most recent billings. The proposed transfer bears a proposed date of October 1, 2016. This date is to coincide with company billing periods and allows a mutually agreed closing date. For accounting purposes the bookkeeping records should be considered transferred and effective on that date.

As a result of the sale and transfer of assets, the water rates and service charges will be under the Grant Co, Public Utility District.
