Murrey's Disposal Co., Inc. is excited to announce that we are automating our residential, multi-family can and commercial can routes. Beginning March 1, 2017 we will be providing customers with wheeled garbage carts to replace manually serviced customer provided cans. This program improvement will help alleviate employee injuries and offer a better service package to our customers.

We have filed a request for approval of this new program with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) to recover the capital investment, and other costs required for this new program. The last general rate increase was approved by the WUTC June 1, 2016.

Cart delivery will start March 1, 2017 and continue through May 31, 2017. If your current service is 1-20 gallon can you will receive 1-20 gallon cart; if your current service is 1-32 gallon can you will receive 1-35 gallon cart; if your current service is 2-32 gallon cans you will receive 1-64 gallon cart; if your current service is 3-32 gallon cans, or more, you will receive 1-95 gallon cart.

If the new program is approved, the proposed rates below will become effective March 1, 2017. The new rate will be applied the first pickup of the next month after the cart is delivered to your service address. The rates below include the disposal increase effective March 1, 2017.
