Commission Staff's confirmation of compliance.

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 11, 2017, J & B Enterprises was issued a \$1,000 penalty for violations of RCW 19.122. J & B Enterprises was provided the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, the full penalty on the conditions that: (1) J & B Enterprises attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA); and (2) J & B Enterprises commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the ensuing 12 months. On May 23, 2017, J & B Enterprises submitted a response accepting the penalty suspension conditions.

Staff has confirmed that the first condition of the penalty waiver was met when J & B Enterprises attended NUCA Dig Safe training on Oct. 17, 2017. Additionally, staff confirmed that according to commission records, J & B Enterprises has not committed further violations of RCW 19.122 within the past 12 months, meeting the second condition of the penalty waiver.

As both conditions of the Commission's penalty assessment in this docket have been met, staff recommends the suspended \$1,000 penalty amount against J & B Enterprises be permanently waived and the docket closed.
