**RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment DG-171154**

Dear Mr. Mahlman:

As you are aware, on December 7, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Absolute Excavating, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2) for failing to provide the required notice to a one-number locator service not less than two business days before excavating. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated January 24, 2018, indicating that the balance of \$2,500 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$2,500 payment due and owing.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,500 balance.
