As you are aware, on January 16, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment in the amount of \$6,500 for violations of WAC 480-15-555 (Criminal Background Checks) and 480-15-560 (Equipment Safety). The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated March 8, 2018, indicating that the \$6,500 balance was due. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due, or any portion thereof.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$6,500 balance.
