As you are aware, on January 16, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment in the amount of \$6,500 for violations of WAC 480-15-555 (Criminal Background Checks) and 480-15-560 (Equipment Safety). The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated March 8, 2018, indicating that the \$6,500 balance was due. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due, or any portion thereof.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$6,500 balance.
