Dear Mr. Johnson:

On August 31, 2018, Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) filed with the Commission rate revisions to its electric and natural gas Schedule 129 Low Income Program. Approximately 140,000 electric and 58,000 natural gas customers would see increases in their bills as a result of this proposal.
