Status of Compliance of Company Named in Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 12, 2018, the Commission served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Commercial Ferry Certificate and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on Argosy L.P. The Notice informed Argosy L.P. that the Commission would cancel the company's authority unless, within 30 days, the company (1) came into compliance with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual report and paying the required regulatory fee or (2) requested a hearing to demonstrate why the company's authority should not be canceled.

On November 30, 2018, Argosy L.P. came into compliance with annual report and regulatory fee submission requirements. The company also paid a late filing penalty of \$1,000 pursuant to Revised Code of Washington 81.04.080(2)(a)(iii).

Because Argosy L.P. has come into compliance, the Commission need not cancel the company's certificate. Staff recommends that the Commission close this docket without further action.
