Dear COGGINS, DUANE:

On September 2, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) notified you that your transportation certificate would be canceled unless you submitted acceptable proof of insurance by October 2, 2016. Our records show that you failed to submit acceptable proof of insurance by that deadline. As a consequence, **the Commission has CANCELED your certificate. You must immediately CEASE all operations associated with this certificate.**

You have the right to a hearing. If you believe the Commission should not have canceled your certificate, you may ask the Commission to schedule a hearing before an administrative law judge. At the hearing the only issue the Commission will address is whether you had proof of insurance on file to avoid cancellation. Your request should be addressed to Steven V. King, Secretary, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Dr. SW, P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, WA 98504-7250. You may also email your request to records@utc.wa.gov. The Commission must receive your request within 14 days after the date of this letter.

You may apply to reinstate your certificate. Download the reinstatement application at www.utc.wa.gov. To locate the application, go to Quick Links on the front page, select "Transportation Permit Applications" and the appropriate industry application.

RE: Charter/Party Bus Services

Dear Mr. Coggins:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) believes that you are engaging in passenger transportation services that require a certificate of authority from the Commission. The purpose of this letter is to learn more about the transportation services your company offers and provide technical assistance with respect to Washington's passenger transportation licensing requirements.

One or more of the vehicles registered to your company as defined in WAC 480-30-036, requires a charter certificate from the Commission. Commission records show that you have not obtained the **required** charter certificate to operate charter services. Providing these services without a charter certificate is illegal, considered a gross misdemeanor, and punishable as defined in RCW 81.70.220 and WAC 480-30-246.

To avoid enforcement action by the Commission, no later than Oct. 9, 2017, please do one of the following:

- Submit a completed application, file proof of insurance, and include the application fee to the Commission. For questions about the application process, please contact our Licensing Services staff at (360) 664-1222

Or

- Explain in writing why you believe your business does not require passenger transportation authority from the Commission. Please explain the nature of your operations in detail. Direct your written response to Rachel Jones, Compliance Investigator at P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, WA 98504 or by email at rjones@utc.wa.gov.

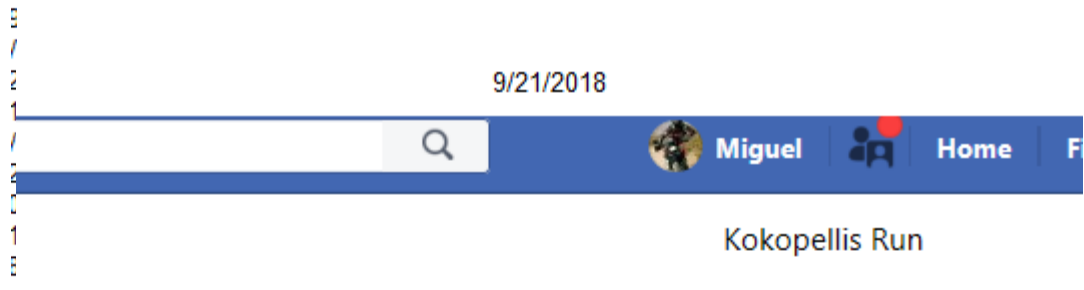
