Enclosed herewith are proposed tariff 7 pages 2 and 32 for Upper/Okanogon Valley Disposal issued January 14, 2019 to become effective March 1, 2019. The revisions are due to rising Okanogon County disposal fees from \$74.00 per ton to \$81.50 per ton. This filing is for disposal fee pass-through only affecting Okanogon County drop box customers only. The revenue impact to the company will increase drop box revenue approximately \$2,830 or .18 % of total revenue (\$1,616,851). Our last general rate case was 2011. Customer notices to those drop-box customers will be included with the first billing.
