**NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING
AND CLOSING DOCKET**

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of All Star Moving, LLC for Compliance with WAC 480-15-555, WAC 480-15-560, and WAC 480-15-570*
Docket TV-190115

TO ALL PARTIES:

In February 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) staff (Staff) inspected the operations of All Star Moving, LLC (All Star Moving or Company) and documented 319 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-15. Based on these violations, Staff proposed an "unsatisfactory" safety rating for All Star Moving and notified the Company of the proposed rating on February 15, 2019.

On March 13, 2019, the Commission issued a notice informing All Star Moving that the Commission would cancel the Company's household goods carrier certificate as of April 17, 2019, unless the Company obtained Commission approval of a safety management plan or voluntarily canceled their permit prior to that date. In the notice, the Commission scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding for April 12, 2019, to allow parties an opportunity to make oral statements.

On March 29, 2019, Staff filed a letter stating that the Company had submitted a voluntary cancellation form in Docket TV-190188. The Company's permit THG067505 was voluntarily cancelled on March 22, 2019. As a result, Staff's letter in this docket requested that the Commission cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for April 12, 2019.

Taking into consideration the fact that the Company has voluntarily canceled its permit and is no longer a regulated company, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding set for April 12, 2019, and close this docket.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Commission cancels the brief adjudicative proceeding in docket TV-190115 scheduled for April 12, 2019, and closes this docket.
