**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO PETITION
(By Wednesday, June 19, 2019, at 5 p.m.)**

RE: *In the Matter of Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County, Washington's Petition for Declaratory Order Regarding Application of WAC 480-109-200, Docket UE-190459*

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On June 3, 2019, Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County (Chelan PUD) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for Declaratory Order (Petition) in Docket UE-190459. Chelan PUD requests that the Commission approve the generation from incremental efficiency gains at the Chelan Hydroelectric Project as an eligible renewable resource as defined in RCW 19.285.030 for the purposes of compliance with WAC 480-109-200.

The Petition asserts that the Department of Commerce (Commerce) has issued an Advisory Opinion designating incremental generation from the Chelan Hydroelectric Project as an eligible renewable resource in the Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System based on Chelan PUD's engineering report. The Advisory Opinion recognized 5.42 percent of total generation at Chelan Hydroelectric Project as a renewable resource.

The Petition requests that the Commission adopt Commerce's conclusion and issue an order declaring that the incremental hydropower at Chelan PUD's Chelan Hydroelectric Project may be used for compliance with WAC 480-109-200 at an eligible amount of 5.42 percent of total production.
