Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on October 7, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Tri City Excavation & Concrete, LLC in the amount of \$6,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.055 for failing to provide the required notice to facility operators through a one-number locator service before excavating. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated December 4, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$6,000 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$6,000 balance.
