Dear Mr. Johnson:

Pursuant to WAC 480-100-198, Notice Verification and Assistance, Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) is providing this statement that it has published the attached notice in the above-referenced dockets in accordance with WAC 480-100-194, Publication of Proposed Tariff Changes to Increase Charges or Restrict Access to Services.

On September 6, 2019, PSE filed with the Commission a revision to its electric Schedule 129 Low Income Program and its electric Schedule 194 Residential and Farm Energy Exchange Benefit. Approximately 1,100,000 electric customers would see an increase in their bills due to the effect of these proposed changes. PSE posted the above-referenced filing in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1), Posting of Tariffs for Public Inspection and Review; Web, Telephone, and Mail Access by posting on PSE’s web site.

PSE also states that notice to the public of the filing referenced above was completed in accordance with WAC 480-100-194(2), Publication of Proposed Tariff Changes to Increase Charges or Restrict Access to Services; Published Notice, by providing notice in the form of a published notice in area newspapers. A copy of the published notice that appeared in area newspapers on September 12, 2019, is attached. PSE also provided a copy of the notice to community agencies, posted the notice on PSE.com and provided notice to news editors of area newspapers, television and radio stations.
