As you are aware, on November 20, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Seattle Top Class Limo in the amount of \$3,800 for violations of WAC 480-30-191 (Insurance), WAC 480-30-221 (Safety Requirements), 49 CFR Part 382 (Controlled Substance and Alcohol Use and Testing), and 49 CFR Part 393 (Safe Operation).
