Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Commission staff (Staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Segmental Systems, Inc. (Segmental Systems) dated August 19, 2020. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

• \$1000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive the full penalty amount if Segmental Systems: commits no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the next 12 months, and the owners of Segmental Systems complete National Utility Contractor Association (NUCA) Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Notice.

On October 20, 2020, the Commission received a response from Segmental Systems admitting the violation occurred and accepted the Commission's offer to suspend the \$1,000 Penalty Assessment based on the stated conditions.

Staff is not aware of any new violations of RCW 19.122, indicating that Segmental Systems met the first of the two conditions specified in the Notice. On December 21, 2021, Staff received verification of training completion from Segmental Systems, this demonstrates the second condition has been met.

Staff believes Segmental Systems has fully complied with the commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the commission waive the suspended \$1,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
