Enclosed, please find revised pages 2, 21, 23, 24, 29, 30, 32, and 33 to the above-referenced tariff. These proposed revised tariff pages contain increased rates for residential and commercial garbage collection services. The requested rate increase is necessary to comply with the Kittitas County Resolution No. 2020-085 passed by the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners on April 21, 2020. This resolution reflects an increase in disposal fees from \$105.16 to \$116.33 to become effective on July 1, 2020. The increased rates, if approved by the commission, would increase Company revenue by approximately \$94,000, and residential and commercial garbage rates by 4.9%. The effective date of the proposed tariff revisions is July 1, 2020.

In addition to the above tariff changes I am including with this filing tariff page 31 for our commercial services in Grant County which was not shown in Tariff No. 12 on the WUTC web site. I believe this to be just a clerical error whereby this page was erroneously deleted as this page is currently in effect and was previously approved in TG-143115.

Also, enclosed for your review are our accounting workpapers and Resolution No. 2020-085. Upon approval by the Commission, affected customers will be notified of this rate change on their next regularly scheduled billing.

Resolution Setting Fees For Solid Waste Disposal

WHEREAS: The Kittitas County Board of Commissioners has the responsibility of managing the countywide Solid Waste System under terms of the RCW 70.95, RCW 36.58 and the Joint Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement of March 12, 1979; and

The Joint Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement provides for the system to be operated on user fees and that the County Board of Commissioners are obligated to set disposal rates as necessary to cover expenses from user fees; and

WHEREAS: RCW 36.58.040 allows for a County to have full jurisdiction and authority to manage, regulate, maintain, utilize, operate, control and establish the rates and charges for those solid waste handling systems, plants, sites, or other facilities

WHEREAS: RCW 36.58.020 allows the Board of County Commissioners to make such rules and regulations as may be deemed necessary for the use and occupation of such sites and may provide for the maintenance and care thereof.

WHEREAS: It has been determined that a fee increase is needed due to increased disposal costs associated with the new agreement with Waste Management,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of County Commissioners does hereby adopt the following Fee Schedule. Effective July 1, 2020. This does not change any other rates not listed currently charged by the Solid Waste Department for the disposal of Appliances, Liquid waste or tires.

All persons using a county owned and operated solid waste disposal system facility shall pay the service fees set forth in the solid waste service fee schedule. The solid waste service fee schedule and any revisions to the service fee schedule shall be prepared by the Director and submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The solid waste service fee schedule will be based on full cost recovery standards.

Listed fees are subject to applicable taxes. The director or designated employee shall, at the time of payment, round the total service fees and taxes owing up to the nearest whole dollar when any fraction of a dollar owing is \$.50 or greater, and round the total service fees and taxes owing down to the nearest whole dollar when any fraction of a dollar owing is less than \$.50.

ALL FEES AND CHARGES, including existing fees and charges not changed by this resolution, are subject to accrual and application of interest at the rate of 18% when more than 30 days past due.
