DECLARATION OF ROBERT HARTFORD

I, Robert Hartford, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declare as follows:

- 1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a compliance investigator in the Consumer Protection Section. As a compliance investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility and transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate household goods carriers that may be operating without the required Commission permit.
- 2. On Nov. 1, 2019, Commission staff found advertisements on Thumbtack for Real Pro Moving, which identified itself as a household goods moving company. The advertisement offered to provide household goods moving services in the area of Seattle, Washington. The advertisement also provided a company contact name of Roberto Ywamoto.¹
- 3. On Nov. 1, 2019, Commission Staff searched Commission records and verified that neither Real Pro Moving nor Roberto Yam Ywamoto is a permitted household goods carrier.
- 4. On Nov. 4, 2019, the Commission sent a compliance letter to notify Roberto Ywamoto that Real Pro Moving must cease and desist operations as a household goods carrier in Washington until the company obtains the required household goods carrier permit from the Commission.²
- 5. On Nov. 6, 2020, I found advertisements on Thumbtack for Real Pro Moving, which identified itself as a household goods moving company. The advertisement offered to provide household goods moving services in the area of Seattle, Washington.³

- 6. On Nov. 6, 2020, I searched Commission records and verified that neither Real Pro Moving nor Roberto Yam Ywamoto is a permitted household goods carrier.
- 7. On Nov. 24, 2020, I searched the Washington State Department of Revenue's website. The results produced a company name of Roberto Yam Ywamoto d/b/a Real Pro Moving (Real Pro Moving), governing person Roberto Yam Ywamoto, a UBI number of 604-409-648, and an address of 6707 196th St. SW, Apt. 405, Lynnwood, WA, 98036-5993.
- 8. On Dec. 15, 2020, I sent a text message to the phone number listed on Real Pro Moving's Thumbtack ad, (206) 474-0266, and requested a move from Kirkland to Bellevue, Washington. I received a reply from an unidentified representative of Real Pro Moving stating that they provide a 16' box truck, two movers at a rate of \$100 per hour with a two-hour minimum, a travel fee of \$50, and an estimated time of three to five hours.⁵
- 9. On Jan. 14, 2021, I checked Commission records and verified that neither Real Pro Moving nor Roberto Yam Ywamoto is a permitted household goods carrier.⁶
