RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Velocity Electric Corporation  
Commission Staff's recommendation to impose suspended penalty Docket DG-200484

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On August 31, 2020, Velocity Electric Corporation (Vecor or Company) was issued a \$1,000 penalty for a violation of RCW 19.122. Vecor was provided the opportunity to have the \$1,000 penalty waived on the following conditions;

- Vecor commits no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the next 12 months.
- The owners of Vecor complete National Utility Contractor Association (NUCA) Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Notice.

On September 16, 2020, the Commission received a response from Vecor admitting the violation occurred and accepted the Commission's offer to suspend the \$1,000 Penalty Assessment based on the stated conditions.

Staff is not aware of any new violations of RCW 19.122, indicating that Vecor may have met the first of the two conditions specified in the Notice. On October 20, 2021, and November 2, 2021, staff contacted Vecor with reminders the Commission had not received verification of NUCA Dig Safe Training completion. Staff has not received a response from the Company as of November 19, 2021.

Staff recommends the Commission impose the full penalty amount of \$1,000, making that amount due and payable immediately.
