IMPORTANT NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGE

Dear Green Direct Customer,

Puget Sound Energy (PSE), on December 1, 2020, filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to increase rates under its Schedule 139 Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy Purchase Rider, effective January 1, 2021. PSE is making this filing in order to correct an accounting error in the calculation of the Energy Charge Credit of \$0.045634 per kWh that became effective on October 15, 2020, following the conclusion of a general rate case filed in 2019. If approved, the corrected credit rate would be \$0.044838 per kWh, an increase of \$0.000796. Across all Green Direct customers on all rate schedules, monthly bills would increase an overall average of 0.84 percent. Combined with all electric charges on your bill, changes for each rate schedule are listed below.

Please note that Green Direct customers will still realize a net benefit as this corrected credit is still marginally higher than the 2021 Energy Charge for Green Direct.
