Re: Ed's Disposal, Inc - G-110 General Rate Filing

Attached please find Original Tariff No. 6, as well as supporting documentation for a general rate filing and price adjustment.

With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a general rate increase to recover higher general operating costs and capital investment costs. We request this rate increase become effective May 1, 2023.

Ed's Disposal's last general rate filing was effective June 1, 2017.

The results of the Lurito-Gallagher Model indicate a decrease of \$9,000 or .33%. However, if approved by the Commission, this filing will result in a decrease of approximately \$82,000 or 3.45%. This decrease impacts approximately 3800 residential, 289 commercial, and 23 drop box customers.

Included in this filing is our non-regulated operation, as our regulated and non-regulated operations share one facility and certain management costs. To protect certain non-regulated proprietary information, we are submitting this filing as confidential, and are filing in accordance with WAC 480-07-160.

A rate increase notification letter will be mailed to all customers affected by these proposed changes no later than March 31, 2023.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Chairman of the Benton County Board of Commissioners.
