IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR PUGET SOUND ENERGY CUSTOMERS ABOUT CHANGES IN ELECTRIC AND NATURAL GAS RATES

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) recently filed requests with the state Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to adjust electric and natural gas rates. The requested changes, effective on November 1, 2023, include:

- Energy Exchange Credit (listed on bill): An overall decrease in electric rates for residential and farm customers of 0.38 percent due to an increase in the amount of the Energy Exchange Credit, based on agreement with the Bonneville Power Administration.
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions Cap and Invest Adjustment: PSE has requested to increase natural gas rates by an overall
 average 2.13% percent, to recover costs from January 1, 2023, through September 30, 2023, for the costs to comply with
 the Cap and Invest Program.
- Purchased Gas Adjustment (listed on bill as "Gas Cost"): PSE has requested to decrease natural gas bills
 under the purchased gas adjustment rate-setting mechanism, which allows utilities to adjust rates, up or down, to
 reflect fluctuations in the price of natural gas in the wholesale market. Projected natural gas costs, which include a
 combination of short- and longer-term wholesale purchases, are anticipated to be lower than currently effective rates.
 The net effect of the PGA would decrease rates by an overall average of 24.20 percent. PSE is not allowed to profit on
 the natural gas it purchases for customers.

Some electric customers are billed every other month. During the UTC's consideration of these proposed rates, other rates may change due to pending or previously approved rate filings.

The UTC will review each filing and has the authority to set final rates that may vary from PSE's requests, either higher or lower or structured differently, depending on the results of its review.
