IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR PUGET SOUND ENERGY CUSTOMERS ABOUT CHANGES IN ELECTRIC RATES

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) recently filed a request with the state Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to adjust electric rates. The requested change is proposed to be effective on March 1, 2024.

Schedule 141TEP Transportation Electrification Plan Adjustment Rider: An annual true-up of the surcharge to recover the costs of PSE's Transportation Electrification Plan (TEP), resulting in an overall increase of 0.04 percent. Such costs include capital, depreciation, and 0&M expenses for electric vehicle charging products and services.

The proposed overall average changes for electric customers are as follows:
