Dear Irrigation Customers,

Summit View Water Works LLC (Summit View) has filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) a request to adjust the irrigation water rates which may result in a change in the rates on your invoice. If the UTC approves this request, new rates will become effective September 1, 2024. Therefore, for all irrigation customers the new rates will be in effect for the 2025 irrigation season.

While the last rate increase for irrigation customers was in 2019, Summit View has not had a rate increase since 2020, but has continued to experience increases in operating expenses over that interval. Set forth below are the proposed adjustments to irrigation rates for the 2025 irrigation season:
