Re: TV-220750 – Authorizing Transfer and Reinstatement of Temporary Household Goods Permit THG069982

Dear Eko Logistics WA LLC:

On October 11, 2022, Eko Logistics WA LLC, d/b/a Green Movers, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a combined joint application to reinstate and transfer permanent household goods carrier authority in the state of Washington. While ownership of Eko Logistics WA LLC has changed, the permit THG069982 remains under that legal entity.

The Commission provisionally grants your application. Eko Logistics WA LLC is now authorized to operate on a temporary basis.

The Commission will evaluate whether Eko Logistics WA LLC qualifies for permanent authority. To qualify for permanent authority, your company must satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Operate for at least six months.
- 2. Personnel responsible for company management and operations must attend a Commission-sponsored training class to learn about the consumer protection rules, safety regulations, and industry-wide tariff provisions that apply to your business. You must sign up for training on the commission's website at www.utc.wa.gov/hhgtraining. Click on the "Online Registration Form" and complete the required fields.
- 3. Allow the Commission to review your business operations and records. Commission staff will review records and inspect vehicle(s), and you must receive a satisfactory safety rating as a result of that review.

- 4. Complete a criminal background check on each person Eko Logistics WA LLC employs or intends to employ. The Commission will not grant permanent authority if any company employee has been convicted of any crime within the past five years involving theft, burglary, assault, sexual misconduct, identity theft, fraud, false statements, or the manufacture, sale, or distribution of a controlled substance. Even if a conviction for any of these offenses is more than five years old, the Commission will not grant permanent authority if it determines that the nature or extent of the crime(s) will likely interfere with the proper operation of a household goods moving company.
- 5. Pay any outstanding monetary penalty or fee owed to the Commission.
- 6. Resolve all consumer complaints pending with the Commission.

Enclosed is a consumer survey to assist the Commission in evaluating Eko Logistics WA LLC's application. Please provide a copy of this survey with return postage to each of the company's customers.

Eko Logistics WA LLC must comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
