On November 12, 2004, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to initiate a rulemaking to consider revision of WAC 480-120-450. The rulemaking inquiry will review WAC 480-120-450, Enhanced 9-1-1 (E911), obligations of local exchange companies, to consider, among other things, amendment of the current rule, or adoption of additional rules to address the allocation of Enhanced 911 implementation costs between local exchange telecommunications companies and Public Safety Answering Points.

Interested parties filed comments on December 10, 2004. Responses to Commission questions and additional comments were filed by interested parties between February 4 - 25, 2005.
