Avista Corporation hereby submits an original and seven (7) copies of revised pages to the Full Settlement Stipulation and Appendix 2 thereto. Corresponding changes have also been made to the attachments to the Joint Motion and Joint Testimony.

The Full Settlement Stipulation and Appendix 2, filed with the Commission on August 18, 2014, included an incorrect amount for LIRAP funding increases of \$112,000 (or 2.8 percent) electric and \$221,000 (or 12 percent) natural gas. These amounts reflected funding computations based on twice the Schedule 1 (electric) and Schedule 101 (natural gas) base rate increases, rather than twice the Schedule 1 and Schedule 101 billed rate increases. The resulting increases in LIRAP funding should have been \$200,000 (or 5 percent) electric and \$214,000 (or 11.6 percent) natural gas, as was intended by the Parties. These amounts were correctly reflected in the Joint Testimony.
