Dear Ms. Washburn:


The matter that has been referred to the Commission from federal court is entitled in short style as “Washington Exchange Carrier Association, et al., Plaintiffs, v. LocalDial Corporation, an Oregon corporation, Defendant.” The “et al.” refers to the WECA members that are directly affected by LocalDial’s operations. Each of those companies is listed as a separate party in the federal court case. The original and sixteen copies of this letter are being filed.

The latest version of the caption for Docket UT-031472 lists the Washington Exchange Carrier Association as a single complainant. WECA and the individual plaintiffs have no objection to the caption in this docket remaining as it is, so long as it is understood by all parties that the individual companies are also real parties in interest and their tariffs, as well as WECA’s tariffs, are matters that should come before the Commission.

Of course, WECA and its member companies would have no objection if the caption of this docket is changed to read “Washington Exchange Carrier Association, et al., Complainants, v. LocalDial Corporation, Respondent.”
