Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 10, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01 in Docket TG-190476. Order 01 approved, without condition, the Settlement Agreement and accompanying Joint Narrative as filed by Commission Staff and Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. ("Company") on December 3, 2019. Among the conditions placed on the Company by the Settlement Agreement was the requirement that the Company file a general rate case ("GRC") with the Commission by July 1, 2020. On April 6, 2020, the Company filed a letter with the Commission seeking an extension of time to file its GRC "until at least September 1, 2020" due to ongoing complications related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Staff did not object and the Company received the requested extension.

On August 17, 2020, the Company filed a "[f]urther extension request" due to the ongoing pandemic, the apparent inaccessibility of some of the Company's books and records, and health issues. The Company requested a new deadline of December 15, 2020, to comply with the Commission's requirement that it file a GRC. Staff does not object to the Company's further extension request.
