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**SCHEDULE 43**  
**INTERRUPTIBLE PRIMARY SERVICE FOR TOTAL-ELECTRIC SCHOOLS**  
(Single phase or three phase at the available Primary distribution voltage)

**AVAILABILITY:**

1. Service under this schedule is available to permanently located schools whose total water heating and space conditioning requirements are supplied by electricity with the following limitations:
  - a. Service is available to all customers receiving service under this schedule as of September 30, 1993.
  - b. For schools not receiving service as of September 30, 1993, service is available if:
    - (i) Such school has received an approved Energy Conservation Report (ECR) from the Washington Energy Office prior to October 1, 1993, and started construction prior to October 1, 1994.
    - (ii) Prior to October 1, 1995, such school demonstrates, in the sole judgment of the company, that a significant financial commitment has been made toward construction and that service under an alternate schedule would create an economic hardship for the school and its community.
2. After September 30, 1995, service under this schedule is available only to those customers:
  - a. receiving service under this schedule as of September 30, 1995, and
  - b. that have installed all conservation measures recommended as cost effective under the provisions of Schedule 83 by such date.
3. All necessary wiring, transformers, switches, cut-outs, and protection equipment beyond the Point of Delivery shall be provided, installed, and maintained by the Customer, and such service facilities shall be of types and characteristics acceptable to the Company. The entire service installation, protection coordination, and the balance of the load between phases shall be approved by Company engineers.

**PEAK LOAD INTERRUPTION:**

The customer shall interrupt electric loads to a level not to exceed .6 watts per square foot of structure between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any day the Company requests interruption. Any electric loads in excess of .6 watts per square foot of structure shall be subject to the CRITICAL DEMAND provisions below.
