NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING (Set for May 4, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.)

 RE: In re Application of Beeline Tours LTD d/b/a Seattle Express for Extension of Certificate C-001052 of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Passenger and Express Service as an Auto Transportation Company, Docket TC-220090

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 10, 2022, Beeline Tours LTD d/b/a Seattle Express (Beeline) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for an extension of its existing Bus Certificate (Application). On February 15, 2022, the Commission served a Notice of the Application on its list of persons requesting such notification.

On March 16, 2022, Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc., d/b/a Premier Airport Shuttle/Capital Aeroporter (PAS-CA) filed a protest to the Application.

On March 22, 2022, the Commission issued a Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (BAP); Setting Time for Oral Statements, which set time for oral statements on April 21, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.

On April 20, 2022, the Commission issued a Notice Rescheduling Brief Adjudicative Proceeding, which rescheduled the BAP for May 4, 2022.

On May 3, 2022, PAS-CA filed a letter with the Commission requesting to withdraw its protest to the Application. PAS-CA represents that it has consulted with Beeline, and the companies agree that concurrent operations for the service Beeline has applied to provide will best meet the needs of the traveling public to the satisfaction of the Commission. The Commission finds that PAS-CA has stated good cause to withdraw its protest and grants the request.

Because PAS-CA's withdrawal of its protest resolves the disputed issues in this proceeding, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the BAP scheduled for May 4, 2022.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for May 4, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. is cancelled.
