Dear Dave Dorland:

We have received your letter of May 14, 2004 that indicates that your attorney seeks approval by the Washington Utilities Trade Commission for a rate change or surcharge for financing of the above-listed improvements. You also indicate that approval by WUTC can take 30 to 45 days. Has your attorney made the application or not? Your letter leaves the answer to this question unclear. According to our records, you have been making application to WUTC for upgrade to this system since December 12, 2001 in response to the same requirement. The requirement to provide disinfection at a level of CT of 6 in accordance with WAC 246-290-451 was required by letter dated January 18, 2001. The improvements are long overdue.

Previously I have prepared an agreement to establish a formal schedule for installation of disinfection. You are certainly welcome to update that agreement for my consideration. At a minimum I would ask for a complete schedule – date of application to WUTC (if you are still intending to do so), start of construction, and completion of construction with submittal of the construction report. I would appreciate a response within fourteen (14) days.
