

The Toledo Telephone Company, Inc. (company) serves approximately 386 square miles in rural western Washington. We have a customer base of approximately 1500 landline subscribers with a total of 1960 actual lines. Of those 1500 individual customers, 1380 also subscribe to broadband. 100% of our customer base is currently eligible to receive broadband with speeds up to 5mb download.

The company began a complete fiber optic upgrade to the existing 40 year old copper network in 2012. The upgrade is funded by an \$18 million USDA/RUS loan. Every household and business within our service area will receive a dedicated fiber optic connection capable of delivering voice, video and data, with speeds up to 1 gigabit. The company currently provides gigabit connectivity to the local anchor institutions including schools, library, EMS and local government. We plan to have the project completed by year-end 2017.


(114) During 2013, the company received \$1,606,140.00 in HCL and ICLS disbursements from USAC. These dollars were primarily utilized to help pay the cost of our fiber upgrade project. (115) & (116) Over 160 subscribers were upgraded to fiber facilities that had been on some of our oldest and poorest quality copper facilities. The new fiber improved voice quality, reliability and provides gigabit capacity for broadband. (117) USF continues to provide essential funding to improve service capacity and allows the company to upgrade an outdated copper network to a high quality fiber optic network.

Lifeline and WTAP Telephone Service Terms and Conditions

ToledoTel has been the local Telephone Company serving the Toledo Washington area for nearly 100 years. We began business when no one else would provide telecommunications services because of the higher costs in serving rural areas of Washington. Since that time, we have also begun to serve neighboring communities, as well as provide other telecommunication type services.

We have served and intend to continue to serve both residential and commercial customers with quality telecommunications services at competitive rates.

In addition to our basic telephone services, we bring advanced telecommunications services to our rural communities, including high speed Internet access, high-speed data services, SIP/IP business telephone service, video surveillance systems, directory advertising, special calling features and voice mail.

ToledoTel participates in the Federal Lifeline and Link-Up Programs, as well as the Washington Telephone Assistance Program ("WTAP"). Under these programs, ToledoTel offers to qualifying low-income customers, discounts off the monthly rate for basic residential exchange service. ToledoTel's current discounted monthly residential telephone rate for customers who qualify for both the Federal Lifeline and WTAP programs is \$8.00, whereas the monthly rate for customers who qualify for only the Federal Lifeline discount is \$11.00. The installation charge for such service may be discounted under the WTAP by up to \$25.00.

The Company's voice lifeline plan includes unlimited local minutes of use within the local calling area. The Company's voice lifeline plan does not include any free minutes of use for Long Distance service.

Local service for Lifeline customers may not be disconnected for nonpayment of Long Distance toll charges.

Toll Restriction Service will be provided to Lifeline customers at no charge.

Lifeline customers are not required to accept Toll Restriction Service as a condition to avoid disconnection of local service for non-payment of Long Distance toll charges.

Lifeline customers are not required to pay a deposit in order to obtain local service if the customer voluntarily elects installation of Toll Restriction Service.

Partial payment from Lifeline customers will be applied first to local service charges and then to toll charges.

Lifeline customers will not be denied reestablishment of service on the basis that the customer was previously disconnected for non-payment of toll charges.

Things to know about the Lifeline Program:

- (1) Lifeline service is a federal benefit paid for entirely by the Federal Lifeline Program. Only eligible consumers may enroll in the program.
- (2) Lifeline Service is available for only one line per household. A household cannot receive benefits from multiple providers;
- (3) A household is defined, for purposes of the Lifeline Program, as any individual or group of individuals who live together at the same address and share income and expenses.
- (4) A Household Worksheet is available for determining eligibility when there are multiple telephone subscribers living at the same residence.

Lifeline services are available to all customers of ToledoTel who qualify based on Federal and/or State rules and regulations. The costs associated with each are reflected each month on a telephone bill along with other charges for services provided by ToledoTel. The services listed above are the basic Lifeline and WTAP services offered by our company. Information about these and other services is available by contacting the ToledoTel business office at 360-864-4552.

There are various ways to qualify for the Federal Lifeline Program or Washington State WTAP Program:

To qualify for WTAP you must certify annually that you participate in one or more of the following programs:

You must notify ToledoTel within thirty (30) days if: you cease to participate in the above federal or state program(s) or; your annual household income exceeds 135% FPGs or; you are receiving more than one Lifeline supported service or; another member of your household is receiving Lifeline support.

You must notify ToledoTel within thirty (30) days of moving. Additionally, if your address listed on your annual certification is a temporary address, you must verity your address with ToledoTel every ninety (90) days. Your name, telephone number, date of birth, last four digits of your social security number or tribal identification number, and address will be transmitted to the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) and/or its agents for the purpose of verifying that you do not receive more than one Lifeline subsidy. Failure to provide this consent will result in your being denied Lifeline service.

ToledoTel may provide to state and Federal agencies, as required by law, for the purposes of complying with the Lifeline program all the information related to your account, including but not limited to your name, date of birth, social security number, usage history, address and phone number.
